

Manufacturers' selection guide

Check mark indicates the manufacturer designed that roller cover fabric specifically for coatings at top of column. Fabrics without check marks are general purpose. But all these fabrics are used for other coatings. Our customers use all of these rollers covers for working with resins and gel coats, even though the manufacturer does not specifically mention those FRP work applications. Woven fabrics are more shed resistant than the knitted fabrics. You can also download from our website, the FRP work selection guide for examples of how FRP shops use these different fabrics.
